



## **In fall 2010, Squirrel Hill Health Center will be bringing its mobile medical unit to a location near you!**

**What is a medical mobile unit?** It is a medical clinic on wheels. The unit looks like an RV and has two private exam rooms and a waiting area. You receive all of the same services in the mobile unit that you can at our office, including physicals, blood work, vaccines and sick visits.

**What if I don't have insurance?** SHHC offers a discount program for uninsured patients. After filling out a short application and providing proof of income, you will receive a letter about your eligibility for a discount. Many patients pay as little as \$15 per visit.

**Who can be a patient on the mobile unit?** Anyone can be a patient! There are no age requirements, residency restrictions, or income limits. Please note, if you have Medical Assistance or an HMO insurance plan, Squirrel Hill Health Center or one of our doctors must be listed on your insurance card in order to be seen by our staff. SHHC also accepts all commercial and public insurance.

**What if I need a doctor now?** SHHC is accepting new patients. You can make an appointment at our office located at 200 JHF Drive, located right before the Homestead-Grays Bridge, by calling **412-422-7442**. Once a regular schedule is set for the mobile unit, you can continue seeing an SHHC doctor in the mobile unit right in your own neighborhood!
