

**HDS' Deaf Youth & Friends (DYF) program** is hosting ASL classes in both Pittsburgh and Greensburg for the Winter 2020 Term. The classes will be held on Saturday mornings beginning February 8 and will continue for ten (10) weeks. The goal of the class is to improve communication between Deaf youth and their hearing family and friends, and to foster understanding of Deaf Culture.

Sessions will be 1 hour long and continue until **10 hours of classroom instruction has been achieved**. The cost is \$15.00 per course. These non-credit courses are inexpensive, informal, and set in two convenient locations in the Greensburg and Pittsburgh areas. A Deaf adult whose primary mode of communication is ASL teaches the class.
